Remember – Reflect – Respond

Exodus 13:11-16

Before moving on in the story Moses writes down more clarifying instructions for how Israel is to respond to God's grace in their deliverance. Why is it important to understand what God requires in our response to Him?

Reflection Questions:

1. Why do you think it's important to take time to reflect on our experiences and what we've learned?
2. How does our culture's emphasis on quick responses affect our ability to reflect?
3. How can reflecting on what God has done help us understand His intentions and love for us?
4. What's the difference between authentic relationship with God and transactional relationships? How is God's redemption an act of love?
5. How can we respond to God's love in our everyday lives? Can you think of specific actions?
6. Why is it important to pass on the truths about God's love and redemption to the next generation?
7. What does it mean to worship God?
8. Why do you think God tell us how to worship Him? What are some ways you see people seem to disregard God's prescription for worship?

Prayer Points:

1. Ask God for a heart of reflection: That we will take time to think about what God has done – and is doing – for us.
2. Thank God for the loving redemption Jesus accomplished on the cross.
3. Ask God for a greater movement in our heart for service to others.
4. Ask God for a heart that incorporates Christ's love into our response toward others.
