Through the Waters of Death

Exodus 14:15-31

We have finally come to Israel's deliverance. As believers today, we are encouraged by Israel's journey through the waters of death, to go forward in faith, knowing that God fights for His people and guarantees our ultimate destiny. We are reminded to fear God, believe in Him, and respond to His amazing grace with obedience and trust.

Reflection Questions:

1. Reflect on instances in your life where you have seen God prepare your heart for something significant.
2. How does viewing Scripture as an interconnected testimony impact your understanding and interpretation?
3. In what ways can fear hinder our ability to move forward in faith? How can we overcome this fear?
4. Consider moments when you have witnessed God fighting for you or protecting you from harm.
5. Reflect on how Jesus' role as our Savior relates to Moses leading Israel through the Red Sea.
6. How does knowing that our salvation is solely dependent on what God has done affect your perspective on performance-based religion?
7. What are some areas in your life where you need to go forward in serving, loving others, or pursuing what God has called you to do?
8. If you haven't been baptized, reflect on any fears or hesitations surrounding it and consider how this passage encourages taking that step.
9. What is your response to experiencing God's amazing grace?

Prayer Points:

1. Ask God to help you better understand His word as he intended it; as one seamless story of love and redemption.
2. Ask God for a deeper faith, one that is steadfast in the face of fear.
3. Praise God for Jesus' saving grace.
4. Praise God for guaranteeing your salvation and for leading you to eternal life.
