God in HD: Holy Priest

Leviticus 20:7-8, 26; 1 Peter 1:1-2

What's the purpose of this series? (Colossians 1:9b-14) To know God and grow in the knowledge of God.

God as Holy Priest:

- The Role of the Priest is a mediator: 1) To represent God to the people and 2) To represent the people to God.
- God is holy and calls us to be holy (Leviticus 20:7-8, 26; Matthew 5:48).
- We are not holy and consequently stand under the wrath of God. (God's wrath is the divine righteous rejection of all that is evil and wrong.)
- God, as Holy Priest, makes a way for us to be holy atonement for our sin (Leviticus 16; 1 Peter 1:2).
- The Holy Spirit testifies that we are forgiven and does the deep cleansing transformation in our lives.

What is Baptism?

Baptism signifies entrance into the household of faith and is a symbol of repentance and inner cleansing from sin, a representation of the new birth in Christ Jesus, and a mark of Christian discipleship.
