### **Unoffendable: What About Injustice?**

Scripture: Romans 12:17-21

**Question:** Isn't anger about injustice justified? Shouldn't we be angry at injustice?

#### **Some say, YES! "The Angry Christian"**

- The Pattern:
  - Strongly held beliefs (maybe biblical, maybe influenced by other things including politics)
  - A threat to those beliefs
  - Because this is a "righteous cause" outrage feels justified
- The "right" and the "left" both do this albeit with different issues
- *...our anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires.* (James 1:20)

#### **Some, including Brant Hansen (and the Bible), say, NO!**

- *Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice.* (Ephesians 4:31)
- *Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.* (Romans 12:21)
- Christians should DO something about injustice
- A Christian's motivation should not be anger, but love for God and love for neighbor

#### **But what about when horrible stuff happens to us or those we love?**

- Will we still trust God?
- How to exhibit trust in God:
  - Live unoffendable, get rid of anger, offer forgiveness
  - Wait on the Lord (Psalm 27:14, Proverbs 20:22, Psalm 37:7-8) - specifically, wait for Jesus' return when he will redeem and heal our broken world.
