Advent is the patient, hopeful waiting for Jesus' arrival. Simeon and Anna embody the Advent message because they patiently and hopefully waited for the fulfillment of God's

promises.

We too are waiting for the fulfillment of God's Advent promises – Jesus' return when all things will be made new, and God's Kingdom will reign forever.

About waiting:

- Everthing that happens is not God's will...
 - We live in a sinful broken world
 - We have free will that oftentimes goes against God's will
 - God's Kingdom reign has broken into our darkness (Christmas!)
 - We live in the "already/not yet" reality of God's Kingdom
- ...but God has a will in everything that happens.
 - Follow Jesus wholeheartedly
 - Cling to hope as we wait for his return
 - In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I
