Pause: To Surrender

Luke 1:26-38

Summary of previous two weeks about knowing God's will:

- 1. **God's general will** revealed in the Bible for all people:
 - To be reconciled to God through grace made available through Jesus' death on the cross
 - To follow Jesus and his ways
 - To be transformed and live out God's mission in this world
- 2. God's specific will for any given situation a process of discernment
 - Scripture
 - Prayer and other spiritual disciplines
 - Godly Counsel
 - Signs
 - Heart

There is a huge difference between KNOWING God's will and SURRENDERING to God's will.

Overcoming common barriers to surrendering to God's will:

- **Ignorance: Don't know God's will** Know God's word and follow the process of discernment
- Fear: Not sure if I can trust God "Do not be afraid, Mary, you have found favor with God." (Luke 1:30) You must surrender to God before you can surrender to God's will.
- Uncertainty: Not sure how it will happen "The Holy Spirit will come upon, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you." (Luke 1:35) - You must let go of control to surrender to God's will.
