#### **Recap of relevant background from last week:**

- Ancient Israel was a patriarchal tribal society
- The family unit was called the *bêt'āb* – literally translated as the “Father’s House”
- The patriarch (head father) bore the responsibility for the well-being of the *bêt'āb*
- When the patriarch died, that responsibility would be passed on to his firstborn son
- One of the patriarch’s responsibilities was the role of **Redeemer**

#### **Stories of Redemption**

- Boaz redeeming Ruth and Naomi from poverty due to death (Book of Ruth)
- Abraham redeeming Lot from capture through war (Genesis 13-14)
- Hosea redeeming Gomer from slavery due to prostitution (Book of Hosea)
- Jesus giving his life as a ransom for us (Mark 10:45)
