FEAR NOT – Anything is *Possible!*

Psalm 23

Best Fear = Fear of God

Worst Fear = Fear of Man

What Does it Mean to Fear God?

- Awe and Wonder
- Reverence and Respect
- Obedience and Submission
- Desire to Please God
- Responsibility and Accountability

What Does Fearing God NOT Mean?

- Simply A Fear of Punishment or Divine Wrath
- Fear of Slavery
- Desire to Please Everyone

Psalm 23 reminds us that: God is with us, God leads us, God provides, and God restores.

Anything is possible with God when we _____ our entire lives to Him.

James 4 reminds us: we are called to submit to God not the world. We can't choose both!

Your Invitations:

- Take time to ask God in what ways have you been too cavalier in your relationship with Him. Ask for forgiveness, repent, and turn towards Christ again today!
- If there are fears in your life that you know control your time and attention, Take time to write those down in a prayer to God and ask God to be in control of your life. Ask God to help you lay down your life to him today!
- Utilize the prayer wall and write out a prayer to God about what areas of your life you fear more than Him.
- Find a Scripture verse about fearing God that resonates with you and work to memorize it.
