



## Week 10 - You are Part of a Global Family

**Series Passage:** Ephesians 1-3

**Focus for the Week:** Ephesians 2:11-22, Matthew 28:16-20

### **Discussion Guide:**

**Q:** Have you ever been denied entry to an event or location? Why?

**Q:** What are the different types of barriers that we see in our world? How do those barriers affect our identity?

**Read:** Ephesians 2:11-22

**Q:** Paul refers to Jesus as our chief cornerstone; what do you think of when you hear that?

**Read:** Matthew 28:16-20

**Q:** Both passages point us to the fact that Christianity is for the entire world. How does this impact our view of what it means to be a disciple of Christ?

**Q:** What impact does knowing that you are part of a global family have on your identity?

### **Finishing Well:**

Jesus was not just a saviour for the Israelites but for the entire world. It is Jesus that unites people from across the world and history. The good news is a message for all people, no matter your circumstances, family history, race, income status, nationality, etc. Jesus' death and resurrection break down those barriers, and it is through centering our lives on him that we grow closer together as the global family of Christ.
