

Bridge Church Home Groups Questions

Series: Unstoppable Part 1 – A Study in Acts Message: The Kind of Friends you Really need Pastor Ryan Pedde

Read Acts 2:42-47 & Acts 4:32-37 and then use the following questions to kick-start your discussion:

- 1. Our verses take place during the first formative days of the early church. After Pentecost the church was propelled into mission. One of the reasons the church grew so exponentially was it was an attractive, counter-cultural community. What aspects of these verses struck you as most counter-cultural in 21st century Canada?
- 2. From our very beginnings Acts 2:42-47 has been formative for Bridge Church. Luke lists key practices of early Christian community in this section of Scripture. Take some time as a group to identify as many community practices from these verses as you can.
- 3. Since this is likely your first gathering of the new home group year, discuss as a group what it would look like to adopt these key community practices? i.e. what will times of Scripture, prayer and fellowship look like together?
- 4. Read Leviticus 19:33-34 and Acts 2:47. The early church was a multiplying community that made space for newcomers. Discuss as a home group what it might look like to make space for newcomers in your gatherings. End with a time of prayer for the Holy Spirit to work in your home group this year.
