

Walk With the Word

John 20

20:1-10 – The empty tomb is discovered by Mary Magdalene.

The “other disciple” is probably John.

When John saw the linen wrappings, he believed.

20:11-18 – Mary arrives at the tomb: she is weeping.

Unlike Peter & John, she sees two angels.

Mary turns and sees a man but doesn't know He's Jesus.

Jesus reveals Himself to her and she begins clinging to Him.

Mary departs and tells the disciples, "I have seen the Lord!"

20:19-23 – In the evening, Jesus appears to the disciples.

Jesus breathes on them to receive the Holy Spirit.

Jesus gives His disciples authority to forgive or not forgive.

20:24-31 – Thomas is absent and declares he won't believe.

In the following passages, the word “believe” occurs 7 times.

“These words have been written so that you might believe.”

Believing that “Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God” promises
eternal life!
