

Walk With the Word

Luke 9

9:1-11 – Jesus sends out the 12 for healing and proclaiming.

9:12-17 – The feeding of the five thousand.

9:18-27 – Jesus' question to Peter, "Who do you say I am?"

Peter responds by identifying Jesus as "the Christ of God."

Jesus informs His disciples of His death and resurrection.

Those who "follow" Jesus must (1) deny themselves,
(2) take up their cross, and (3) lose themselves.

9:28-36 – The “Transfiguration”: Jesus’ meeting with Moses and Elijah represents the Law and the Prophets.

9:37-42 – Jesus heals the boy of the unclean spirit.

Point: this event and the following indicate the disciples have a long way to go.

9:43-45 – Jesus warns His future is precarious.

9:46-48 – A spat among the disciples betrays their spiritual immaturity.

9:49-50 – Concern over someone casting out demons in Jesus' name.

9:51-56 – Anger toward the Samaritans betrays their naiveté.

9:57-62 – Jesus declares the cost of following Him.
