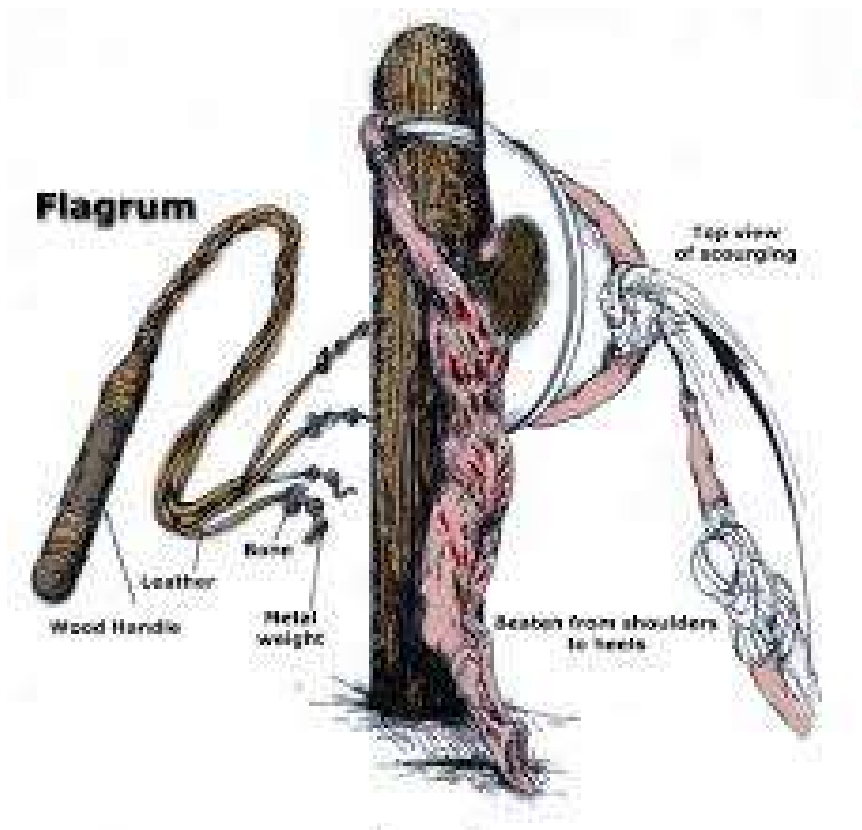


Walk With the Word

John 19

19:1-16 – After Jesus' meeting w/ Pilate, Jesus is scourged.



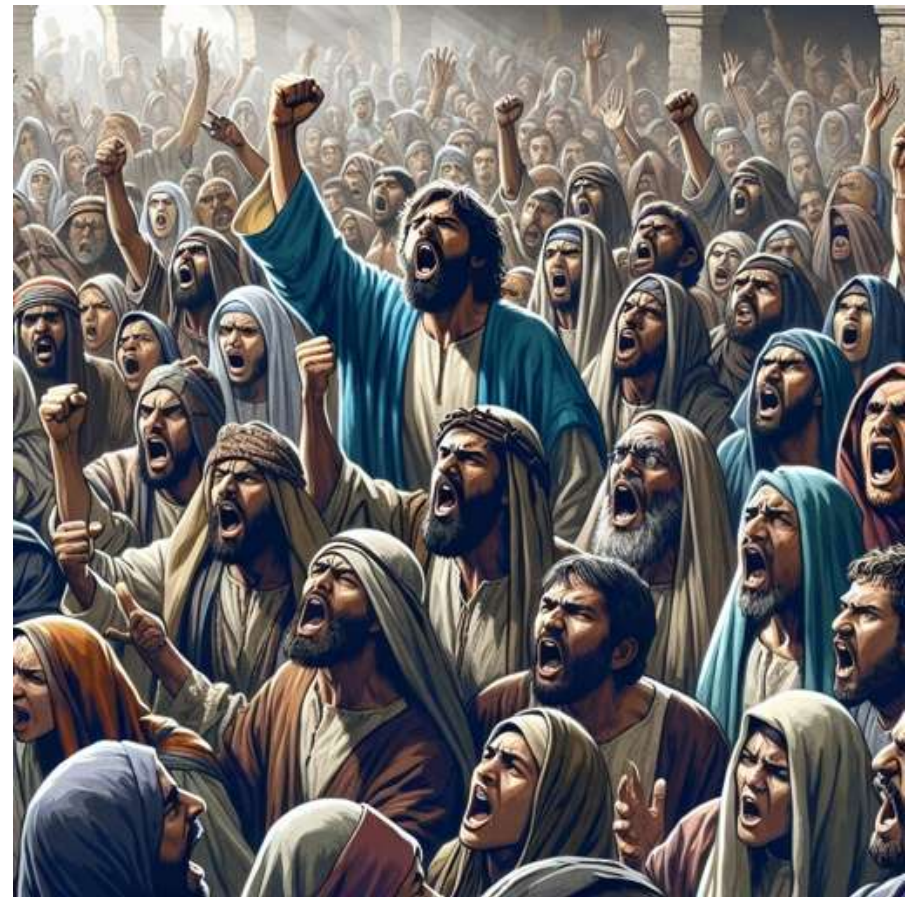
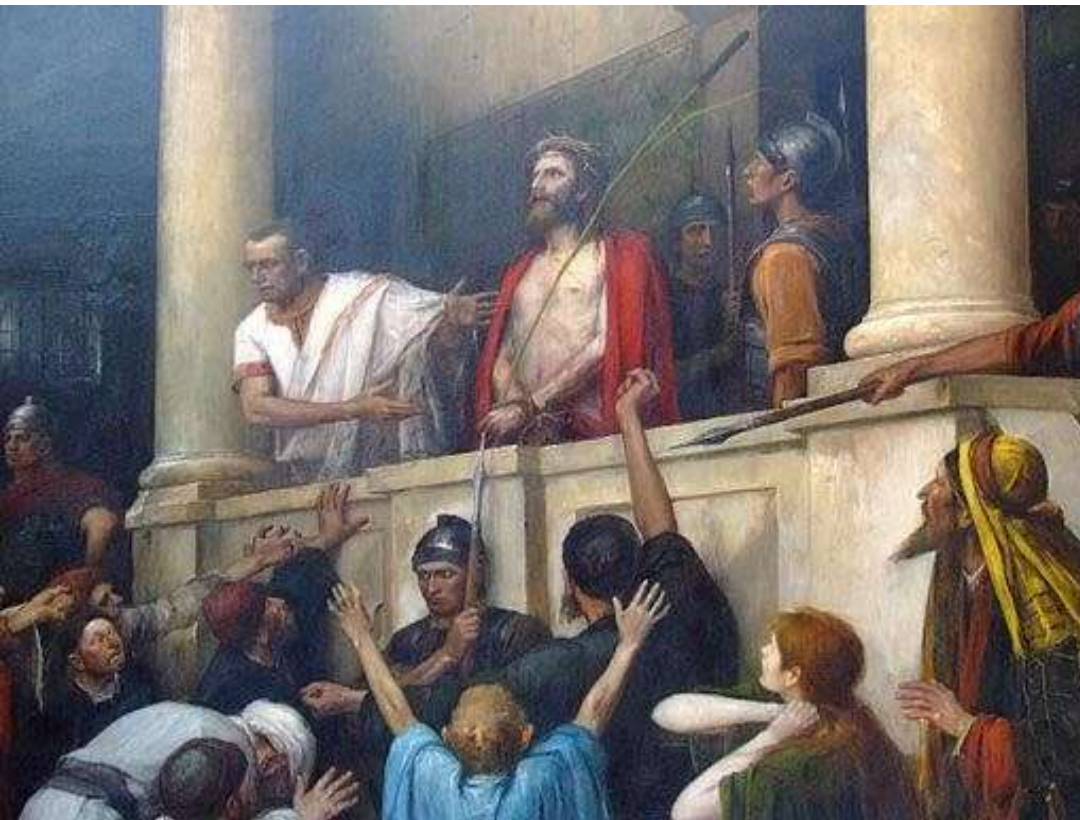
The act of scourging took a victim near death.

Pilate interviews Jesus again and claims “no guilt.”

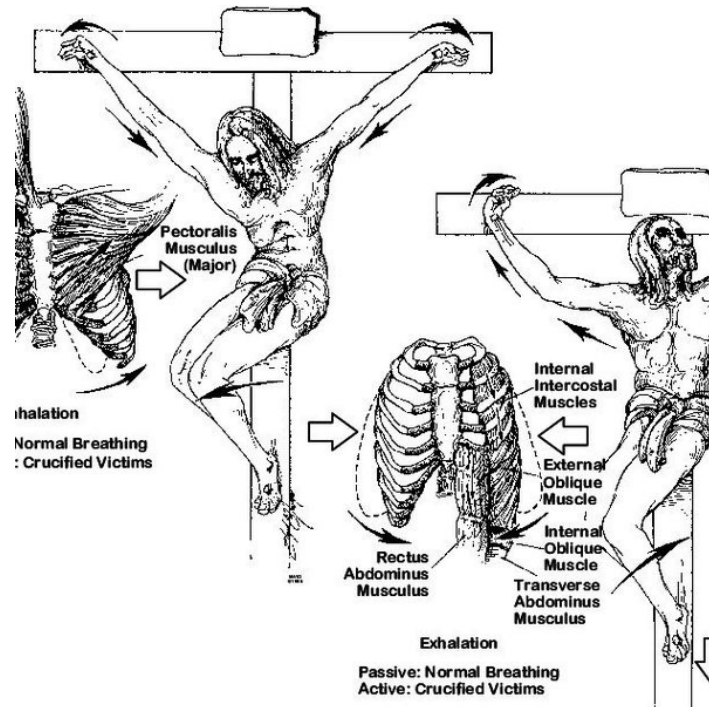
Jesus states Pilate’s authority has been given “from above”:
this puts Pilate in greater responsibility.

Pilate is intimidated by the crowd: “You are no friend of Caesar!”

Pilate tells the crowd, “Behold, your king!” But the crowd cries out, “We have no king but Caesar!”



19:17-30 – Jesus is taken to be crucified at Golgotha.



Pilate commands the inscription: “Jesus the Nazarene, the king of the Jews.”

The soldiers cast lots for Jesus' tunic: fulfills *Psalms 22:18*.



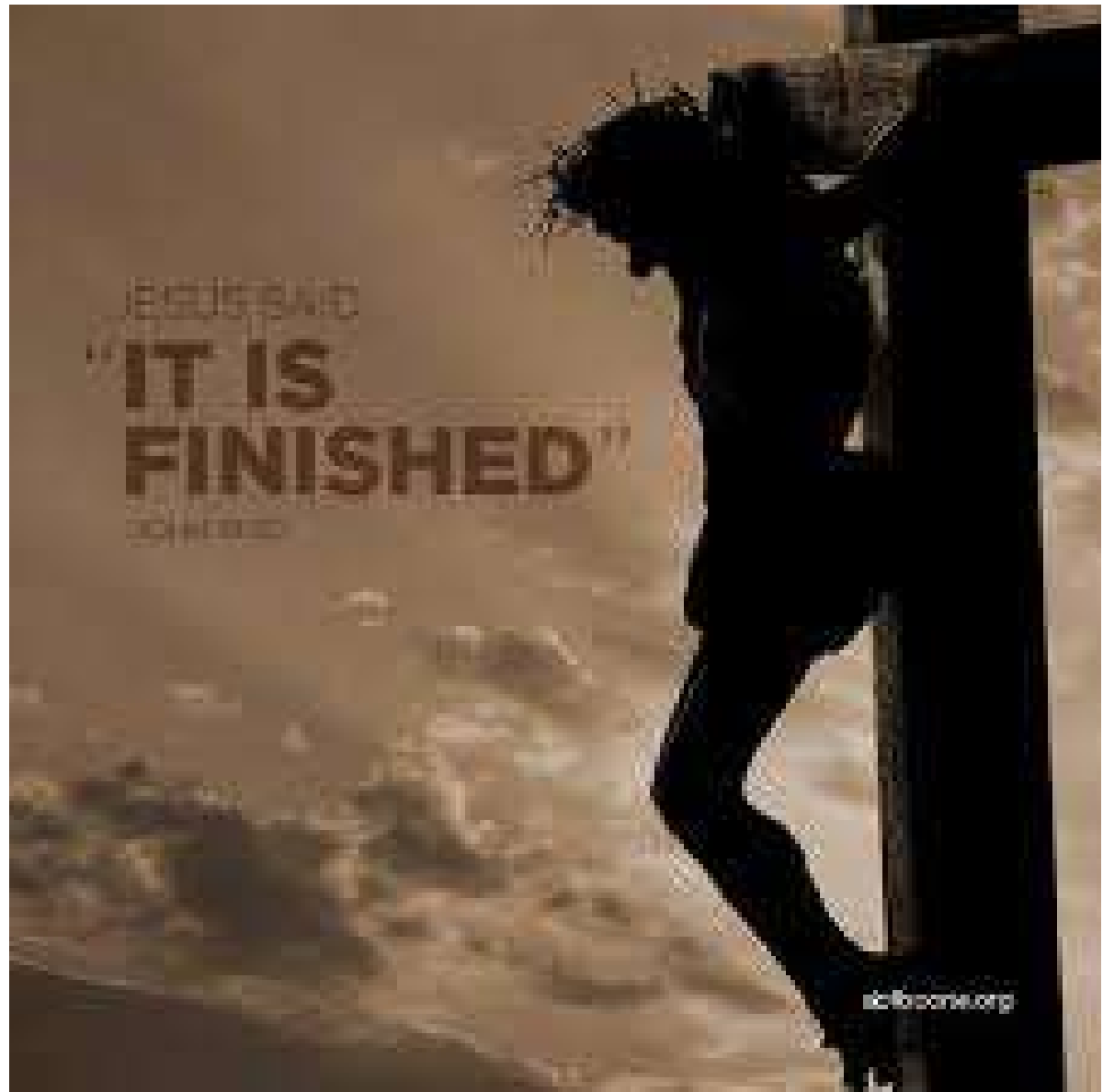
At the scene of the cross, there were 4 women and John.



Jesus instructs John to look after *His mother*.



Jesus declares,
"It is finished!"

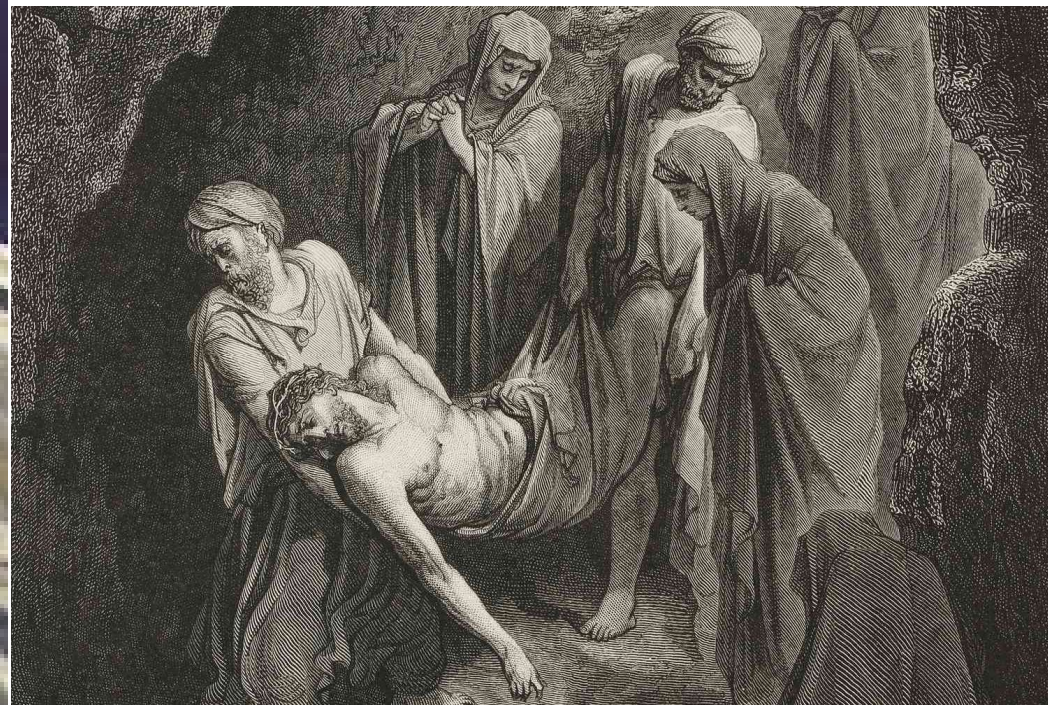


19:31-42 – Jesus' legs are *not* broken: this fulfills *Psalm 34:20*.

When Jesus' side was pierced, out flowed *blood and water*.



Jesus is prepared for burial by Joseph and Nicodemus.



Jesus is entombed in the Garden of Gethsemane.
