

Walk With the Word

Mark 6

6:1-6 – The astonishing rejection of Jesus in His hometown.

States specifically here that Jesus had 4 brothers.

Jesus is unable to do miracles because of their unbelief.

6:7-13 – Jesus sends out the twelve for on-the-job training.

They are to preach the need to repent.

They are not to spend energy on those who won't believe.

6:14-29 – Death of John the Baptist, the last OT prophet.


Herod the Great

(10 wives, 14 sons; murdered a few)

Archelaus
Ruled 4 BC to AD 6
(born loser)

Philip & Herodias
(Lived in Rome)
Have daughter Salome

Herod Antipas
(In Jerusalem; visits Rome)
Divorces his wife and marries
Herodias, Philip's wife.



John the Baptist
condemns this union
and is beheaded
at the request of
Herodias

6:14-29 – Death of John the Baptist, the last OT prophet.

6:30-44 – The feeding of the five thousand.

12 baskets full left over: represents the 12 tribes

6:45-56 – Jesus walks on water.

Harbours in Galilee in time of Jesus (plotted by Mendel Nun)



6:45-56 – Jesus walks on water.

The storm: a symbol of future persecution.

Key message about the storm: “Do not be afraid.”

The “insight” the disciples were getting: Jesus is God.

Note: The chapter begins with those who do not believe and ends with those who do believe.
