

Walk With the Word

John 1

1:1-18 – Jesus Christ, the “Word” made flesh.

The “Word (*logos*) means a concept or thought.

The “Word” made flesh means the concept has materialized.

Therefore, the “Word” becomes the “Light of the world.”

To “believe” means to trust in , rely upon, and adhere to.

Those who truly “receive” Him follow Him (v. 43).

1:19-34 – The ministry of John the Baptist.

John identifies Jesus as the lamb of God.

John identifies Jesus as the Son of God.

1:35-51 – Jesus begins gathering His disciples.

Andrew, Peter, Philip, and Nathanael.

Key words (again): “Follow Me.”

Summary:

God came in the flesh, and we are to *follow Him.*
