7:1-10 – Healing the centurion's servant.

The centurion was a Gentile who love the nation.

The centurion was a Gentile who showed great faith.



7:11-17 – Raising the widow's only son in Nain.

The consequences of a widow losing her only son.

Jesus touches the bier.



7:18-35 – The inquiry into Jesus' identity by John the Baptist.



Jesus' answer describes acts attributed only to the Messiah.

The need for baptism was rejected by lawyers and Pharisees.

7:36-50 – Dinner at the house of Simon the Pharisee.



Jesus' feet are anointed w/ costly perfume by a sinner.



Jesus addresses Simon's lack of normal hospitality.

Jesus forgives the woman's sins based on her faith.
