

Walk With the Word

Luke 6

6:1-11 – Jesus declares Himself Lord of the Sabbath.

On the Sabbath, He “works.”

On the Sabbath, He heals.



6:12-16 – Jesus chooses the 12 apostles.

Peter—to Antioch & Rome; crucified by Nero @ AD 66

Andrew—north to Russia/Turkey; martyred.

James—to Spain(?); back to Jerusalem; executed by Herod Agrippa 1.

John—cared for Mary; exiled to Patmos; died in Ephesus.

Philip—to Egypt/N. Africa; crucified upside down (like Peter).

Bartholomew (Nathanael)—Armenia/Beirut; beheaded.

Thomas—traveled to India and was martyred.

Matthew—Mediterranean areas; martyred in Ethiopia.

James (son of Alphaeus)—N. Israel(?); stoned by Jews in Jerusalem.

Simon the Zealot—to Egypt/Persia/Lebanon; in AD 65, martyred.

Jude (Thaddeus)—martyred in Lebanon.

Matthias—stoned by Jews; beheaded by a Roman soldier in Jerusalem.

6:17-19 – Following Jesus, in the crowd, are many Gentiles.

6:20-49 – Luke's synopsis of the Sermon on the Mount.

Jesus probably preached “the sermon” 100s of times.

The most important theme: treat *everyone* w/ love.
