

Walk With the Word

Mark 11

11:1-11 – Jesus’ triumphal entry into Jerusalem.

Riding on a colt fulfills the prophecy in Zechariah 9:9.

“Hosanna” means “save us now!”

Also fulfills Psalm 118:26, a Messianic prophecy

11:12-14 & 19-21 – The fruitless fig tree is a picture of the Jewish nation.

11:15-18 – Cleansing the temple: a lesson against spiritual corruption.

11:22-26 – A warning against misplaced faith.

Our faith is not to be in the church, or pastors, but in God.

We are to believe that “all things” will work out in the end.

Key: “...have received...” is in “perfect tense”: no time frame.

This also applies to forgiving others.

11:27-32 – Those who don't believe question Jesus' authority.
