Question #1-Who is my neighbor?


Anyone God has put in our sphere. Anyone we can show mercy on. The people on our block. Our enemies.(Luke 6: 27-36). Our Family.

- Being emotionally safe in your marriage is the key to a happy healthy and thriving marriage
- They found that the number one predictor for divorce is not fighting, or the content of arguments...but emotional disconnection.
- Definition of emotional connectedness: Can your spouse turn to you in any circumstance knowing you are trustworthy and will be emotionally available and will respond to them in a caring manner.



Philippians 2:5 -8 In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; rather, he made himself nothing by taking the very nature of a servant being made in human likeness.
