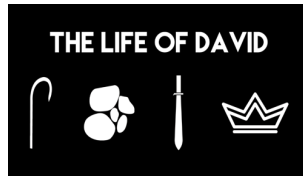

Title: David Turns Around

Reference: 2 Samuel 12:1 - 13

Main Idea: When confronted with the evil of his sin David repented, authenticating his faith in God, and placing him on the path of spiritual renewal.

Outline:

Three take away truths from David's sin and repentance

1. We cannot hide our sin from God.
2. Sin always results in consequences.
3. God is gracious, and eager to forgive our sins when we repent.

Questions for further contemplation and application after the message:

1. What do we mean when we say that God is omniscient?
2. Romans 8:1 says that "there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus." Does that mean that there are no temporal consequences for our sins?

What, then, does it mean?

3. How would you define repentance?

How would you explain repentance to a new believer struggling with sin?
