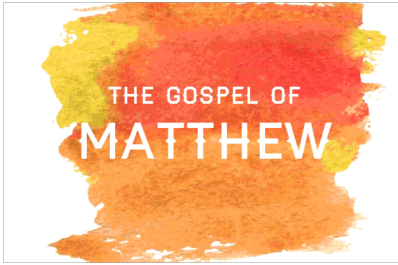

- 3) Do you agree that Peter might well have viewed the transfiguration as an indication that the fulfillment of the judgment described by Jesus in 16:27 was imminent?
- 4) Survey Matthew 16:13 through 17:8. What lessons can we learn from Peter’s initial triumph and subsequent struggles?
