Questions for further contemplation and application following the message:

1) God's judgment for Israel's idolatry arrived in the form of the three-year drought and accompanying famine pronounced by Elijah in 17:1. Do you find this troubling in any way?
What is the ultimate consequence of sin?
2) In 18:22, Elijah accused the people of Israel of hesitating (limping back and forth) between two opinions because of their attempts to serve both the LORD and Baal. How are people guilty of this in our time?
3) Read Isaiah 44:9-20 and take note of the folly of idolatry.
