Main idea: God Is Just

Questions for further contemplation and application following the message:

1. What evidences are given in 21:3 that Naboth was a man of good (righteous) character?
2. Why do you think it was so easy for Jezebel and Ahab to murder an innocent man?

Was their worldview a product of their religion?

3. After Elijah confronted Ahab over Naboth's murder and prophesied his judgment, he (Ahab) seemingly turned in the direction of repentance (21:27-29). Do you think Ahab's actions were genuine, or simply the product of fear?

What are the evidences of genuine repentance?

4. What sins will God not punish?
