Breakfast With Jesus

John 21:1 – 14

Main Idea:

Some time after His resurrection, Jesus welcomes a group of His disciples back to the shore after a disappointing night of fishing.

Two Takeaways:

- 1) The resurrection of Jesus from the dead is a fully attested historical fact.
- 2) The loving service of other believers is an inescapable part of the calling of every true disciple of Jesus.

Questions for further contemplation and application after the message:

#1 How does the resurrection of Jesus assure us as His believers that our salvation in Him is real and secure?

#2 How does the resurrection of Jesus insure our own future resurrection as believers? (Consult 1 Cor. 15)

#3 What details from today's text stand out to you as things you would expect to find uniquely in an eyewitness account?

- What was John's purpose in writing his gospel? (See 20:31)

- Is it significant that he was an eyewitness? Why or why not?

- It was argued in the message that servanthood is so essential to discipleship that the two cannot be separated. Do you agree? Why or why not? Support your answer biblically. (Matthew 20:20-28, etc.)
