Message Summary

Being a disciple of Jesus and making disciples isn't a suggestion—it's a command. It's the Family Mission. And though it may be uncomfortable and costly, it is the assignment for every believer.

Jesus has:

1. Authority to command
2. Authority to influence
3. Authority to rewrite stories

And if we are co-heirs with Christ, then we carry that same authority to:

- Preach the gospel
- Make disciples
- Live boldly for Him

But there is a cost: time, intentionality, sacrifice, and consistency.

What Discipleship Requires

- **Caring enough** to step into someone else's story.
 - **Loving people** when it gets messy.
 - **Showing up faithfully**, even when they fall short.
 - **Teaching Scripture** and **living it out**.

- Bold faith like **Peter**? (Matthew 14:29)
 - Doubt like **Thomas**? (John 20:25)
 - Obedience like **Mary**? (Luke 1:38)
 - Fear like **Jonah**? (Jonah 1:3)
 - Compassion like the **Good Samaritan**? (Luke 10:33–35)
 - Passionate worship like **David**? (2 Samuel 6:14)
 - Truth like **John the Baptist**? (Matthew 3:2)
 - Consistent prayer like **Daniel**? (Daniel 6:10)
 - Bold testimony like the **delivered man**? (Mark 5:19)

Why Your Life Matters

1. People may never read the Bible—but they will read **your life** (2 Cor. 3:2).
 2. Words don't prove Jesus—**your walk does** (James 1:22).
 3. Your **transformation** is evidence of His power (2 Cor. 5:17).
 4. Your **obedience** can unlock someone else's breakthrough (Rom. 10:14).
 5. You are a **light in dark places** (Phil. 2:15).
 6. **Being set apart** invites the presence of God (Psalm 24:3–4).
