#### **Big Idea:**

#### **Start the Conversation (Icebreaker)**

- What's one word that describes how you feel when you hear "all nations"?

#### **Read Together**

Matthew 28:19, John 20:21, 2 Corinthians 5:18–20

#### **Talk It Out**

1. What stood out most to you from the message and why?
2. Have you ever treated salvation like the finish line instead of the starting point?
3. Who are the "even them" people in your life right now?
4. What makes it difficult to reach or connect with people who are different from you?
5. What would it look like for you to live like you are truly sent this week?

#### **Go Deeper**

- Where might comfort be holding you back from the mission?
- Are there any biases, preferences, or fears God is challenging in you?
- How can you reflect heaven's diversity and unity in your everyday life?

#### **Action Step (Do This This Week)**

Connect with someone different from you.  
Start a conversation. Listen. Pray together.  
Don't just talk about unity... practice it.
