

Advent Devotion - Week 3

Scripture: Psalm 118:24 (NRSV)

This is the day which the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.

Theme: Joy

Movie Quote: "The Code of Elves

Reflection: Buddy the Elf has a nearly unquenchable joy! The spirit of Christmas lives in him and his whole hope is to share love and cheer with the world. This joy is still available to you when you think of the miraculous gift of Jesus.
