

PRAYING FOR HOPE

Community Group Study Guide: Ephesians 1:15-23 – Week of April 16, 2023

1. The Church...

In the passage, Paul is writing to the Church. He even clarifies the characteristics of those within the Church, namely those who have faith in Jesus and love for the saints. The faith that we have holds Jesus as our Savior and King. We acknowledge that He has saved us from our sins, and we rightly submit all of ourselves to His authority. Loving the saints is demonstrated by loving everyone who puts their faith in Jesus. This qualification of the Church is the foundation for everything that Paul would continue to write.

2. ... Should Pray...

Paul explains how he continuously prays for the Church, and that he does so with thanksgiving. Likewise, we should be persistent in pray, and our prayers should include abundant thanksgiving. It is important for us to recognize who God is, and be thankful for all that He has done for us.

3. ... For Wisdom and Revelation of God

Paul is praying that the Church would have the Spirit of wisdom and of revelation of God. He is asking that God open the eyes our hearts. The reason that Paul is praying for this is three-fold. First, it is so that we might know the hope that we have been called to. This hope is the powerful promise that God's good sovereignty is working things together for good. Because we know how everything ends, we can take comfort in the most difficult of times. This is the unshakeable hope that we have when we see the Lord for who He is. Second, Paul prays for us to have our heart enlightened that we might see the riches Gods glorious inheritance. The inheritance that Paul is specifically requesting that we see is that which is already revealed to us within the Church. As we interact within the body, we are able to both give and receive from the blessings of our
