Community Group Study Guide: Genesis 47 – Week of July 30, 2023

1. Joseph Provides for His Family

Jesus tells us in Mark 10 that in the midst of a sinful world looking to do us harm, that we are to be wise as serpents and innocent as doves. God is the giver of wisdom, and He wants His people to righteously use that wisdom to do good for those around them. We see Joesph exemplify this in the end of chapter 46 and into chapter 47. Joesph instructs his brothers on what they should say to Pharoh, in order to best position them within the kingdom. Joesph displays tremendous wisdom, simultaneously soothing any worry in Pharoah while equipping his family for the future. Joesph shows two areas of praiseworthy conduct. First, he displays the wisdom of God, in how he is adeptly able to navigate the political arena of Pharoh's court. Secondly, Joseph is using his capacity and resources to provide for his family. We see in this story a reflection of how God has acted toward us. He has seen our need, and in His grace, He has provided for us. Through Jesus, our righteous older brother, we have been saved from the land that was bringing death, and brought into a new land that brings about life. He has provided for us, and given us instructions on how we are to act. He has done all of this out of His love for us. In response, we are to imitate the actions of Jesus within our own sphere of influence that the Lord has placed us in.

2. Pharoh is Blessed

The effect of Joeseph's wisdom given to him by God ultimately brings a significant blessing to Pharoh. Beyond having the provision of food, Pharoah ends up acquiring all of land, livestock, and livelihoods of all the citizens of Egypt. Once again, we see that the wisdom of God, when implemented, can reap incredible blessings.

Read Genesis 47

- 2. Read Proverbs 18:15 What is the difference between wisdom and knowledge? Is one more valuable than the other? Are they different in how they are acquired? How does this passage change our perspective?
- 3. Was it wise for the Egyptians to sell themselves to pharaoh during the famine? Consider their response in 47:25. How does this apply to the Christians life, today?
- 4. What does it mean to be a sojourner? Why is it valuable to understand that as Christians we ourselves are sojourners? How does it effect the way we view and interact with our day to day lives?
- 5. Read Luke 16:1-9 What is the primary principle of this parable? What impact does it have on your life? How might you reconsider how you interact with others?
- 6. What areas of your life do you have an opportunity to "make friends for yourselves by means of unrighteous wealth?" What would it look like?
