Joshua 14:12 – He Promised Me!

Scripture:

"...but the Lord helping me, I will drive them out." (Joshua 14:12)

Word Study:

Hebron – 'fellowship, association'.

Anakim – 'giants, long-necked ones'.

Season (Chronos) – time of preparation, waiting, or testing.

Moment (Kairos) – divine opportunity when God's timing aligns with obedience.

Point 1: Some Battles Are Necessary

- Destroy unclean territory
- Destroy principalities
- Clear the way for the future

Confession: I refuse to let any giant stand between me and what God said is mine.

Point 2: Fight What Glorifies God & Expands His Kingdom

- Glorify God when giants fall
- Expand the Kingdom
- Inspire testimony in others

Confession: I refuse to let any giant stand between me and what God said is mine.

Point 3: Don't Walk Away From the Fight You'll Win

- You're well able to win
- Victory is assured because of the assignment
- You'll win the fight others won't engage

Confession: I refuse to let any giant stand between me and what God said is mine.
