**God With Us God For Us
An Inseparable Love
Romans 8:31-39 (p. 1123)
Sunday, December 21, 2025

For further reflection:

I. Love Proven (v.31-32)

1) Paul grounds assurance in what God has already done: "He did not spare His own Son." How does looking backward at the cross strengthen your confidence moving forward?

II. Love Pleading (v.33-34)

2) When Paul asks - "If God is for us, who can be against us?" - what are the "against us" voices or realities you feel most strongly right now? As a believer, how does it change your perspective to know that God is for you?

III. Love Preserved (v.35-39)

3) How should a church shaped by Romans 8:31-39 treat struggling, doubting, or wounded believers? Paul says "Who shall bring any charge against God's elect?" (Answer: Nobody!) How does this truth affect how we speak to one another about sin, repentance, and grace?

4) How does the inseparable love described in verses 38-39 give believers courage to live and speak boldly for Christ? Who in your life can you share this great love of Christ with?
