GTI Hope /India Bible Literature (GTI/IBL) is an Indian-based organization that trains and equips the church in India so that it can reach its own people with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. GTI/IBL is staffed by over 150 Indian employees and assisted by 2000 national volunteers. Our support of GTI goes specifically to reach the unreached Koli tribal people. The Koli people are considered "untouchables" and treated like animals. They live in abject poverty with hunger, malnutrition, no education, and no hope.
