

Jesus' precious blood provides perfect purification (9)

Draw near to God
Hold fast the confession of our hope
Encourage one another

Digging Deeper

What aspects of Christ's new **covenant** in Hebrews 8:10-12 do you find most significant?

Can you think of a time when you deeply realized your need to be **cleansed from sin**? Consider David's reflections in Psalm 51:1-12.

What does it mean to you that, if you have put your faith in Christ, you've been purified by His blood? (Hebrews 9:11-15)

What do the two uses of the word "sanctified" in Hebrews 10:10 and 10:14 convey about what Christ accomplished?

What is the **basis** in Hebrews 10:19-21 for the three "**let us**" statements that follow?

Hebrews 10:22. What does it mean to **draw near** to God? What things tend to hinder us from drawing near to God?

Hebrews 10:23. What does it mean to "**hold fast** to the confession of our hope"? Why is this so essential? (Consider Hebrews 10:35-39, which ends on a note of confidence.)

Hebrews 10:24-25. What does it mean to "**stir up** one another to love and good deeds"? What are ways you can do this?

Can you think of a specific way that a brother or sister in Christ has **encouraged** you when we gather together? How can you intentionally **encourage someone else**?
