
The annual Walk and 5K Run for Life, September 20th, is a fun, family-friendly event to raise money for Wellspring Life Ministry to support, strengthen,



For Further Reflection:

True peace is not the absence of conflict, but the presence of Christ—and allegiance to Him may divide before it unites.

- 2) In what areas of your life is it hardest to put Jesus first? What steps could you take to reorder those priorities?
- 3) What do the "reward" statements in verses 41–42 reveal about how God values even small acts of faithfulness? How can we be more aware of the way we "receive" others in Jesus' name?
