As Adam said last week, this isn't a call to try harder. It is a call to fall in love with the Master and the resulting attitude and response will flow from that love.

This parable highlights three groups of people: those who truly knew the Master and had the Master's best interests at heart; those who worked for the Master but out of fear and didn't really know Him; and those who outright rejected the Master. Where do you see yourself in this story?
