

Operation Christmas Child (OCC) is a world-wide Gospel outreach ministry. In October and November, people across the country will pack shoeboxes with hygiene items, school supplies, small toys and other age-appropriate gifts. Those

shoeboxes are shipped worldwide to missionary teams who then host shoebox distribution parties where the Gospel is presented in the child's own language. For those children seeking to commit themselves to Jesus Christ, a 12-week follow-up discipleship program is available.

How to Pack a Shoebox: Operation Christmas Child 2025 kicked off October 26th and runs through November 16th. School supplies, hygiene packs, and assorted shoebox fillers are available for purchase in Activity Room #1. # Mistaking Cleanliness for Conversion Matthew 12:43-45 (page 972) November 9, 2025 Pastor Matt Webster Sermon Notes

I. Parable: The Vacant House

II. Principle: The Vulnerable Heart

#### For further reflection:

- 1. What does this passage teach us about the danger of spiritual "vacancy" of being empty but not filled with God? How does this passage challenge the idea that people can be neutral neither for nor against Jesus?
- 2. What modern examples show people "cleaning up" their lives without actually being changed by Christ? What might it look like today for someone to have their "house swept clean" but still be spiritually empty?
- 3. Jesus describes the evil spirit finding the house "swept and in order." How can we move from merely orderly lives to Holy S pirit-filled lives? What's the danger of focusing on "sin management" rather than heart transformation?
- 4. Jesus says emptiness invites worse things What's one area of your life where you've been focused on sweeping and organizing, but not truly surrendering? What might it look like for you to stop trying to fix yourself and instead invite Jesus to fill you?
