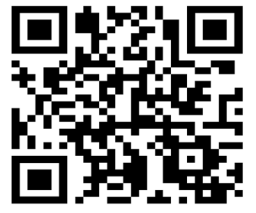

LIVING TODAY IN LIGHT OF FOREVER

Psalm 90:1-17 (page 588)

February 25, 2024

Psalm 90:1-17

Main point: God's will is that our brief lives leave a legacy for His eternal glory.

Remember that God is eternal (vs. 1-2).

We must allow God to be our refuge.

We must trust in the Lord at all times.

Remember that man is temporal (vs. 3-6).

We have a date with death

We have a limited time of life

Remember that man is sinful (vs. 7-12).

God will judge our sin.

God will measure our lives.

God will teach us wisdom.

Remember that God is merciful (vs. 13-17). Chesed

We should long for God's mercy.

We should look for God's glory.

We should live for God's beauty.

Conclusion:

God is great.

Life is short.

Sin is serious.

Wisdom is essential.

Mercy is available.

Success is possible.
