Points to Ponder

1. What is the gospel?

2. Mark 1:14-15 "Now after John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee, proclaiming the gospel of God, 15 and saying, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel." Mark 1:14-15

Examples—Loving your enemies, give to the one who begs from you, etc. see Sermon on the Mount

What is one way I can share the good news with someone this week?

Examples: Offer to pray for someone who doesn't follow Jesus, ask someone who doesn't yet follow Jesus what they think of Jesus and listen attentively, etc.
