#### **Points to Ponder**

Why does Jesus talk about the Kingdom of God more than any other topic?

Are there parts of Jesus' expectations for the people of the Kingdom that challenge me?

Examples–Loving your enemies, give to the one who begs from you, etc. see Sermon on the Mount

What is one way I can share the good news with someone this week?

Examples: Offer to pray for someone who doesn't follow Jesus, ask someone who doesn't yet follow Jesus what they think of Jesus and listen attentively, etc.
