


Thank you for your faithful giving. Ministry needs continue and have increased in some areas. There are several options for giving.

Digging Deeper

- 1. What is my true TREASURE? (what do I worry about, think about, obsess about the most)
 Have you considered God's priorities for your life and for your family?
- 2. Why is it so hard to keep my eyes OFF of my own wants and needs?

Perhaps there are things in your life that you need to limit or eliminate as they tend to distract you from focusing on things God wants you to focus on. Do you have God's provision in mind – or are you trying to make it all work?

- 3. How do I start my day? If its not the Word of God, what is it and how dos that contribute to my thoughts throughout the day? Perhaps a new morning (or evening) routine would allow you to start with God's perspective rather than the load of information and distraction the world is throwing at you.
- 4. Has prayer been a regular part of your daily life and routine?
