




Thank you for your faithful giving. Ministry needs continue and have increased in some areas. There are several options for giving.

## The Prodigal Son(s) Questions for further reflection

Think about the last few times you have been really upset: mad, frustrated, or sad. While it is okay to feel mad, frustrated, or sad (Jesus certainly did!), ask yourself some "why" questions about the intensity of your feelings. Ask God to help you sort through those feelings. Is it possible that some of the intensity you felt is because something you loved more than God was threatened, hurt, or taken away? Ask God to help you see in what ways you love God's stuff more than you love God.

In the parable, the father sat on the porch waiting for his son to return. As soon as he appeared, the father was able to run to him and forgive him. Forgiveness is HARD. Clearly that father had already done the work of forgiveness in his own heart before the boy appeared on the horizon. Is there anyone who has hurt you, and has not yet repented? Have you done the work of forgiving them in your own heart?

Read Luke 15:1-10, the setup and the stories preceding the Prodigal Son(s). What do these stories teach us about the heart of God?

Is there someone in your life who appears to be way holier than you, someone who appears to have it all together? Man looks on outward appearance, but God looks at the heart! They need Jesus just as much as you do! Pray that God would protect them from the trap of relying on their own goodness.
