

# From Claustrophobia to Spaciousness Psalm 4 Pg. 529 November 26, 2023 Dave Shive

### I. David's two-fold problem (v. 1-2)

A. Release is needed from the narrow space into the broad place (1)

B. His "cabinet" has been disloyal to him (2)

#### II. David's two-fold solution (v. 3-4)

- A. He must maintain secure confidence in God (3)
- B. His leaders need to cease their sin (4)

#### III. Steps forward for David and his leaders (5-8)

- A. Leaders: You must restore your trust in the Lord (5)
- B. David: God needs to smile upon us (6)
- C. Leaders: Your trust in bountiful crops is inadequate (7)
- D. David: I sleep soundly because I trust in God's faithfulness (8)

## Psalm 4 Questions for further reflection and discussion

What does spiritual "claustrophobia" look like in your life?

If God were to bring you out into a "spacious place," describe what that would look like.

In Psalm 4, David's leaders have betrayed him. Think of how you have been betrayed by someone you trusted and how you have responded.

How might David's response help you if you are betrayed in the future?

What might God's "smile" on you look like? Do you often sense God's "frown"? Can you picture God beaming a smile in your direction?

As you linger in the "place of restriction," what strategy do you have in place to maintain your confidence in God until he brings you into the "wide open place"?
