

Rescue Mission Project



Since the mid 80's, FCC has partnered with the Baltimore Rescue Mission in their work to "seek the salvation of the lost; instruct believers in the Word of God; conduct gospel and Bible teaching

services; and feed, clothe, and help the needy."

As they have faithfully done this, God has brought men though the front door who are now serving as staff in the mission. Currently, nine of these men live at the mission with basic accommodations: mattresses on the floor, clothes in bags, cardboard for walls and no climate control in the dormitory.

FCC wants to help. Three contractors have offered to donate their skill and expertise to lead us in our Project Baltimore this June. The materials estimate is approximately \$60,000. We would like to raise this amount by May 21st to give us time to purchase materials wisely. Any excess raised will be put in our Missions Care Fund.
