

Who Gets the Blame for Affliction? Psalm 6 (page 530) January 7, 2024	Questions for further reflection and discussion	
Pastor David Shive	As you read Psalm 6, how would you describe David's mood?	
David suffers and fears God may be angry with him (v. 1)		
	Do you see David's mood change or evolve as the psalm progresses?	
David has a lingering illness. God is slow to respond. (v. 2-3)		
David pleads for deliverance because God is merciful (v. 4)	How do you relate to David's struggle with illness and your own personal sicknesses you have experienced?	
David's suffering is a severe illness that he fears may result in death (v. 4-5)	Who does David blame for his illness? Careful: this is not a simple question. In the Bible, there are many layers to unraveling the cause of infirmity.	
David cannot escape his illness even at night (v. 6-7)	What do you think of how David ends Psalm 6 (v. 8-10)? Is it a satisfying conclusion for you? How would you end it if it were your psalm?	

David warns his enemies that God has answered his prayers (v. 8-10)
