

Matthew 10:5-15 (page 968)

Outline:

1) Priority of the Message

1) What does it mean to “freely give as you have freely received”? (v.8) How does generosity reflect the Gospel? Reflect on the beauty of the free gift you have received in Christ. In what ways can you freely give (time, encouragement, resources, hospitality) this week?

2) Posture of the Messenger

2) Do you have a clear understanding of the Gospel message and a clear focus on where God has called you? What steps can you take to ensure clarity in these things as you step into your identity as an ambassador of Jesus?
