Youth Retreat

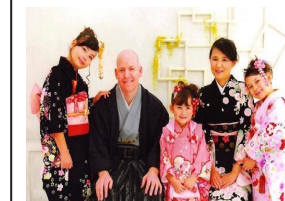


The Wayumi Retreat Experience for youth and their families on
