

Personal Application

What are some steps you can take to remain faithful in the face of persecution? Is there anything keeping you from taking those steps?

What are some of the promises of God to which you cling, especially in difficult and anxious times?

Which arguments for Jesus as the better mediator give you the most comfort and encouragement? Which are most confusing?

Communal Application

"The priestly service of the community is their adherence to their confession (v 1), through which they have expressed their confidence and hope based on Jesus' faithfulness as high priest in the service of God." (ref. Hebrews 3:1)

What does it look like for the community of faith to adhere to their confession?

What does it look like to exhort one another every day? (Hebrews 3:13)

Personal Application

What do you think about the theology of rest outlined in Hebrews 4? Are you holding fast to the promise of God's rest? What would it take for you to begin practicing the rest that God offers?

Missional Application

Hebrews 4:1 says that we should fear lest anyone should fail to enter God's rest. How can we help others be assured that they will enter God's eternal rest?

Have you made the confession that Peter made in Matthew 16:16 – "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God."? If not, would you consider this confession that Jesus is the Son of God and trust Jesus to be your Savior and your Lord?
