

God Speaks Because He Wants to be Known Psalm 19 (page 538) March. 10, 2024 Pastor Dave Shive

I. God created a universe because he wanted to be known – 19:1-6

- II. God spoke his law because he wanted to be known 19: 7-9
- III.. One response is necessary when God speaks 19:10-14

Today we will look at v. 1-6 and next Sunday we will conclude Psalm 19.

- 1. The creation is God's mouthpiece
- 2. The creation is God's means of self-disclosure
- 3. The voice of creation eliminates all excuses for unbelief

- Romans 1

- 4. The voice of creation speaks incessantly for God
- 5. God's glory is the theme of creation's message

Questions for further reflection and discussion

Read through Psalm 19 each day for the next week. One reading takes less than 2 minutes.

Notice the three parts to the psalm (as presented in the outline). Does the flow of the psalm make sense?

Review the seven assertions that v. 1-6 make regarding the creation. Why does the psalmist have so much to say about God's creation?

It seems that God is a God who communicates, as indicated by the references to his speech in v. 1-4b. Why is this important to you?

In v. 4c-6, the psalmist focuses on the sun as the ultimate disclosure of God's glory. In what way does the sun reveal God unlike any other part of creation?

Why does the psalmist use metaphorical language in v. 4c-6 to describe the sun's operations? What is this type of language intended to accomplish?
