










Rescue Mission Project





Baltimore Rescue Mission

The Mission Trip to the Baltimore Rescue Mission is quickly approaching! We're emphasizing the "WORK" part of our 5 W's! Major projects consist of:

- Demolition of third floor of men's quarters (Fri/Sat, 16-17 Jun)
- Reconstruction of third floor of men's quarters
- •Deep cleaning & painting of the kitchen
- Rehab front of chapel; painting; pallets pre-made for backlit wall design; new sound system
- Plumbing fix to water fountain
- Punch lists of items putting in new ceiling tiles; numerous cleaning projects; potential painting projects

Who can help? **ANYONE** who can work! Three contractors have offered to donate their skill and expertise to lead in the demo and reconstruction of the third floor. Some skilled labor is needed for those specific projects, but more helping hands are welcome in other projects where no skills are required just a willingness to work. And if you can't work every day, no problem. Just come when you can. Sign-up in the foyer.

The materials estimate for the project is approximately \$60,000. The deadline to raise this amount is May 28th. An anonymous donor will match up to \$30,000! Please help us reach our goal and support the Baltimore Rescue Mission.
