

#### For Further Reflection:

- 1. Verse 1 says there is "now no condemnation."
  - a. What does "no condemnation" mean in your own words?
- b. Why is this truth foundational for Christian joy?
- What do you think keeps people from living in the freedom of this verse?
   (Examples: guilt, shame, legalism, painful past experiences)
- 3. What does it mean to set the mind on "the things of the Spirit"? a. What competes for your attention or imagination?
- 4. Paul says the mindset of the Spirit brings "life and peace."
  - a. Describe a time you experienced this spiritual peace.
- 5. How does the Spirit's indwelling shape your understanding of daily Christian living?
  - a. What difference does it make that God's presence is in you, not far away?
- 6. Where do you need to experience joy in the Spirit this week? (Forgiveness? Mindset? Strength for a challenge? Peace in anxiety?)
- 7. What is one practical step you can take to set your mind on the Spirit each day? (Prayer, Scripture reflection, gratitude practice, silence, worship, memorizing verse 1)
